History and ideology

- Commission suggested a joint EU-wide monitoring mechanism in 1994 and 1997, EMN pilot phase 2003 - 2008
- Council Decision 2008/381/EC on 14 May 2008 established the legal basis for the EMN.
- The European Commission co-ordinates the EMN in co-operation with National Contact Points (EMN NCPs). Steering committee members from each Member State
- EMN's objective is to provide up-to-date, objective, reliable and comparable information in order to support EU policy making on migration and asylum.
- Dissemination of EMN products through a public website
